

Children aren't safe online

90% of children have access to the internet

71% of tweens experienced or witnessed cyberbullying

10% disclose the incident to their parent or guardian



The situations families and teens face today

The more time your child spends online, the more dangerous situations they will encounter.



Self-Harm/Suicide

36% of tweens and 64% of teens were involved in a self-harm/suicidal situation.



Sexual Content

62% of tweens and 82% of teens encountered nudity or content of a sexual nature.



Predators

9.4% of tweens and 14.2% of teens encountered predatory behaviors from someone online.



Eating Disorders

4% of tweens and 15% of teens engaged with or encountered content about disordered eating.



Anxiety

19% of tweens and 41% of teens used language or were exposed to language about anxiety.



Violence

75% of tweens and 88% of teens expressed or experienced violent subject matter.



Drugs/Alcohol

66% of tweens and 85% of teens engaged in conversations surrounding drugs/alcohol.



Bullying

71% of tweens and 83% of teens experienced bullying as a bully, victim, or witness.



Depression

24% of tweens and 44% of teens engaged in conversations about depression.
